

Planned Maintenance Schedule

(Example)

Weekly Tasks

- 1. Fire Alarm Testing
 - ⇒ Test fire alarm call points to ensure functionality.
 - ⇒ **Legal Reference**: Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005 (RRFSO).
- 2. Emergency Lighting Checks
 - ⇒ Perform a quick test to confirm lights operate during power cuts.
 - ⇒ **Legal Reference**: BS 5266.
- 3. Workplace Inspections
 - ⇒ Check for hazards (e.g., loose wires, spills, blocked exits).
 - ⇒ **Legal Reference**: Health and Safety at Work Act 1974 (HSWA).

Monthly Tasks

- 1. Water Temperature Monitoring
 - ⇒ Check hot water storage (above 60°C) and cold water (below 20°C) to prevent Legionella.
 - ⇒ **Legal Reference**: Control of Substances Hazardous to Health (COSHH).
- 2. HVAC Filters
 - ⇒ Inspect and replace filters if needed for air quality.
 - ⇒ **Legal Reference**: HSWA.
- 3. PAT Spot Checks
 - ⇒ Perform visual inspections of portable electrical equipment.

Quarterly Tasks

- 1. Fire Extinguisher Visual Inspection
 - ⇒ Check pressure gauges, seals, and signs of damage.
 - ⇒ **Legal Reference**: BS 5306-3.
- 2. Pest Control
 - \Rightarrow Schedule professional inspections and treatments if necessary.
 - ⇒ **Legal Reference**: Food Safety Act 1990 (for food-related businesses).
- 3. Roof and Gutter Checks
 - ⇒ Inspect for leaks, blockages, or damage to prevent water ingress.







Annual Tasks

- 1. Gas Safety Check
 - \Rightarrow Arrange for a Gas Safe registered engineer to issue a Gas Safety Certificate.
 - ⇒ **Legal Reference**: Gas Safety (Installation and Use) Regulations 1998.
- 2. Fire Risk Assessment Review
 - ⇒ Update or review the fire risk assessment.
 - ⇒ **Legal Reference**: RRFSO.
- 3. Fixed Wire Testing (EICR)
 - ⇒ Conducted every 5 years (or earlier for high-risk environments).
 - ⇒ **Legal Reference**: Electricity at Work Regulations 1989.
- 4. Fire Extinguisher Servicing
 - \Rightarrow Service by a qualified technician.
 - ⇒ **Legal Reference**: BS 5306-3.
- 5. Legionella Risk Assessment Review
 - \Rightarrow Conducted by a competent professional.
 - ⇒ Legal Reference: COSHH.
- 6. Lift and Escalator Thorough Examination
 - \Rightarrow Inspections as per LOLER requirements.
 - ⇒ **Legal Reference**: Lifting Operations and Lifting Equipment Regulations 1998 (LOLER).

Every 3-5 Years

- 1. EICR Testing
 - ⇒ Frequency depends on property type and use:
 - Commercial: Every 5 years.
 - Industrial/High-Risk: Every 3 years.
 - ⇒ **Legal Reference**: Electricity at Work Regulations 1989.
- 2. Fire Suppression System Maintenance (e.g., Sprinklers)
 - ⇒ Comprehensive checks as per BS EN 12845.

Additional Industry-Specific Tasks

- F-Gas Systems Maintenance (if applicable): Annual leak checks and maintenance.
 - ⇒ **Legal Reference**: Fluorinated Greenhouse Gases Regulations.
- Refrigeration/Freezer Maintenance: Temperature and seal checks.

Record-Keeping

- Digital Logs: Use software to track maintenance schedules, reminders, and certifications.
- Paper Records: Keep hard copies of inspection reports and certifications for audits.
